RELEASE OF LIABILITY, INDEMNITY AGREEMENT AND MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION

Please read carefully before signing. This is a release of liability and waiver of certain legal rights.

("Rock and Roll Prep") allowing me or the Minor to participate in Rock and Roll Prep. I expressly assume all risks associated with or arising from my or the Minor's participation in Rock and Roll Prep, connected activities or use of Rock and Roll Prep equipment and waive any claim I may have related to my or the Minor's participation in Rock and Roll Prep activities.

In further consideration, I hereby **Release and Agree to Hold Harmless, Indemnify and Defend** Rock and Roll Prep and its agents, employees and vendors from any damage, or expenses including actual attorney fees and costs, without limitation, which Rock and Roll Prep, its agents, employees or vendors may sustain as a result of my or the Minor's participation in the Rock and Roll Prep School and associated activities. _____ **(initials)**

EAR PROTECTION WAIVER AND RELEASE

Acknowledgement and Acceptance of Risk

I understand the risk of my child choosing not to wear earplugs or other protective hearing devices when participating in Rock and Roll Prep School programs as a performer, observer, or a stage hand. I expressly agree, for myself and on behalf of my minor child, to accept and assume all responsibility and risk for potential injury or damage to my child's hearing or health that arises from my participation in these programs. I free elect to participate in Rock and Roll Prep School programs despite such known and unknown risks. If I choose not to wear earplugs or other protective hearing devices when participating in such programs, my decision is purely voluntary. I am advised by Rock and Roll Prep School that I should wear protective hearing devices when participating in its programs because doing so may reduce the potential for hearing damage or loss.

In consideration of participating in Rock and Roll Prep School programs, I for myself, and for any minors for which I am the parent or legal guardian do on behalf of myself and such minors and on behalf of my and their heirs, personal representatives or assigns, do hereby **release and hold harmless** Rock and Roll Preparatory, Inc., its subsidiaries, affiliates and their respective members, principles, directors, officers, agents and employees from any and all liability for hearing damage or loss of hearing, and I hereby waive any lawsuit, claim or cause of action for damages arising from injury or damage to my hearing or loss of hearing as well as from any other personal injury resulting from my decision to participate in Rock and Roll Prep School programs. OUR PROGRAMS

Lessons Only

Private Lessons- You will be paired up with a professional musician for one on one, 45 minute (students over 7 years) or 30 minute (students 7 years and younger) weekly lessons. With each lesson, you can expect your teacher to pay close attention to your learning style and teach through theory, charts, and by example. We will encourage you the whole way as we watch your confidence and creativity grow!

Full Program

Each semester, our Music Director and staff put together a set list either consisting of a whole genre of music or a specific band/artist. In addition to your private weekly lesson, you will attend a 3-hour rehearsal with your bandmates for 4 months. Through team work, practice and having fun, you will work together to create an amazing performance held at a local music venue for your End of Semester Show.

Classes are separated by age/grade

Rockers – Students in middle school and high school

Rollers – Students in grades 3rd/4th – 5th/6th

ABC Rockers- This is a program for our youngest students. It is a teacher (and usually an older student) assisted band rehearsal that meet once a week for 1.5-hour rehearsals. They open our End of Semester Show!

Production/Songwriting 1 Program

As with the Full Program, this class runs for a 4 month semester. Each class is limited to 5 students, each with a different instrument. Classes are once a week. Students will meet 2 hours a week for the first 2 months and 3 hours a week for the last 2 months. In this advanced program, you will learn how to write lyrics, create chord progressions, harmonize, record/produce, mix/master and perform your OWN ORIGINAL MUSIC. This is your chance to take the skills you've cultivated from Rock & Roll Prep School to the next level. This class will perform their original music at the same End of Semester show with the Full Program students.

*Must have completed one Full Semester Program at Rock & Roll Prep School to enroll in this class.



ROCK & ROLL PREP VARSITY BAND

Rock and Roll Prep's Varsity Band is a group of select students who rehearse once a week for 2 hours, in addition to their other rehearsal and lesson. They have shown continued growth, passion, encouragement to other students, and have the talent and enthusiasm to represent Rock and Roll Prep School.

Over the years Rock & Roll Prep Varsity Band students have played at St. Andrews Hall, Detroit Grand Prix, Detroit Boat Races, Third Man Records, Hard Rock Café, Jimmy Johns Field, performed with Amy Gore & Her Valentines, recorded on an Electric Six album, appeared on Channel 4 and countless summer festivals and events.
